By shifting the angle, moving closer, stepping back, or even crouching low, students have discovered just how much perspective shapes the story an image tells.

Along the way, students have been applying the technical skills they have learnt such as Aperture Priority to control depth of field, Shutter Priority to freeze or blur motion, and experimenting with compositional strategies like the rule of thirds, leading lines, and creative framing. It’s been wonderful to watch Year 11 experiment, refine, and grow their creative confidence.
